SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GUIDELINES

1. Applicant should meet the following minimum requirements:
 - Completion of Charleston High School education by May 23.
 - Acceptable academic standing
 - Applied, accepted, or currently attending an accredited university, college or junior college for the purpose of pursuing a degree.

2. Applicant must complete scholarship application:
 - Do not use white out (liquid paper)
 - All information must be current
 - Use black ink or blue ink only
 - Legible handwriting or print
 - Folded applications/other documents will not be accepted

3. Applicant must submit the following:
 - Official copy of high school transcript
 - Copy of letter of acceptance from school applicant will be attending
 - If currently enrolled an official transcript from the school
 - Typed/double-spaced 300-500 word essay on what you plan to achieve in your career.
 - Three letters of recommendation from employer, instructor, community representative and/or personal reference
 - Letters cannot be submitted from immediate family members.

4. Completed applications and required documentations must be submitted no later than May 1.
